CASE MEMBERS receive the benefit of representation and advice regarding <u>any</u> work-related concern.

NON-MEMBERS are not entitled to Association assistance on problems that do not arise from violations of the Negotiated Agreement.

- Transfers (non-procedural, merits)
- Observations/Evaluations (non-procedural, merits)
- Class Size (impact)
- Parent Complaints/ Parent Meetings
- Conflict Resolution (staff, admin, community)
- Child Abuse (what to do if accused; procedures)
- Suspension and Dismissal
- Fair Labor Standards/Family Medical Leave
- Lawsuits/ Legal Actions (civil, criminal)
- Special Education Concerns
- Workers Compensation Claims
- Health & Safety/Environmental Conditions
